The Shire's Rest Tour

It is situated on a family farm 8 kilometres away from west of Hinuera and southwest of Matamata in Waikato, New Zealand and is now a Tolkien tourism destination, offering guided tours of the set.



Itinerary:

- Tour starts with a drive through picturesque 1,250 acre sheep farm with spectacular views across to the Kaimai Ranges
- You will be escorted through the twelve acre site recounting fascinating details of how the Hobbiton Movie Set was created
- The Hobbit holes, Green Dragon Inn, Mill and other structures created for *The Lord of The Rings* and *The Hobbit* Films can be viewed and you will see how this beautiful piece of Waikato farmland was transformed into The Shire from Middle-Earth.
